## LINCOLN VILLAGE MINISTRY

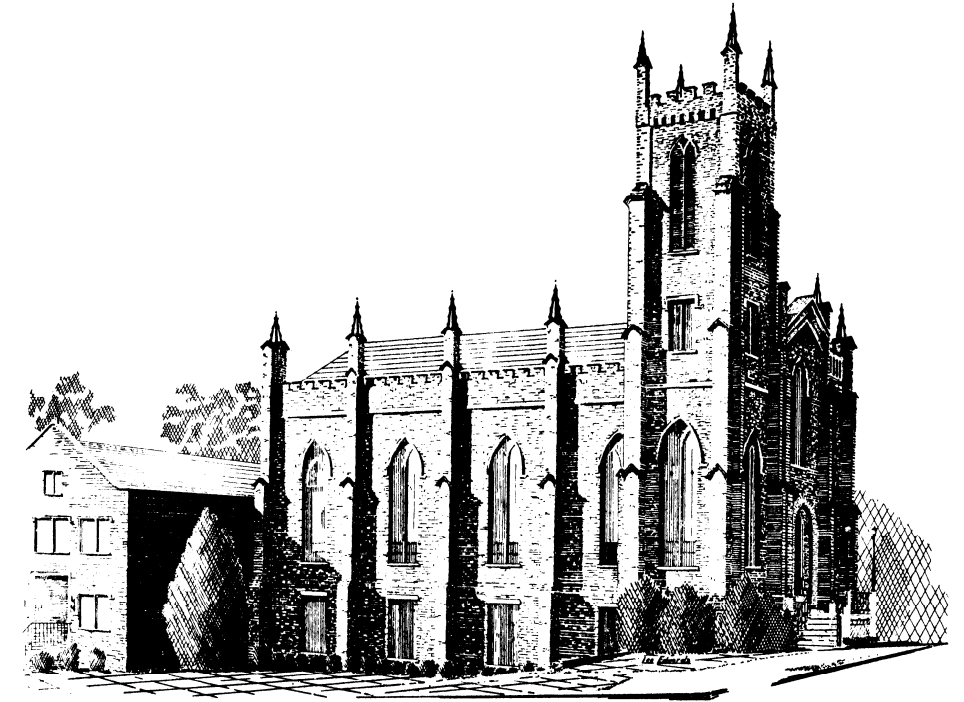
